Job Summary:

The Person-Centered Care Specialist creates and develops cognitive and sensory programs in the three activity spheres of Productivity, Self-Care, and Leisure to engage the participants in MMS Adult Day Center. Facilitates individual activities to complement the uniqueness of each person. Uses a person-centered approach to maintain a healthy social environment for the adults.

Essential Functions:

- Mentors new staff/participants/staff volunteers regarding Person-Centered Care.
- Provides direct participant care. Utilizes dementia-specific principles (especially during bathing, mealtimes, etc.). Pursues additional participant care needs (e.g., nail care, one-on-one care, redirecting and modeling actions).
- Provides assistance and supervision throughout program day to ensure the nutritional activity needs of each participant are met as outlined in the IPC.
- Promotes independence in participant care as appropriate and ensures safety for both participants and the individuals providing care.
- Ensures a person-centered care environment is maintained (e.g., monitors group size and structure, coordinates daily assignments, maintains partners list, coordinates the day).
- Models a customer service attitude towards others. Takes ownership in solving problems. Takes initiative to improve situations.
- Attends care conferences and/or contributes to participant care plans in collaboration with Interdisciplinary Team.
- Demonstrates initiative, flexibility self-motivation and effective time management by:
- Completing scheduled assignments on time.
- Consistently helping other members of the team with their work when own work is completed.
- Accurately records participant's critical information and progress on flow sheets, as appropriate to position. Reports participant's concerns, complaints, and changes in physical or mental function to R.N. - Nursing Supervisor.
- Remains calm in an environment with many demands, frequent changes, and interruptions.
- Applies theory of infection control and good body mechanics to job performance.

Skills:



- Ability to be patient, tactful, and sensitive when dealing with participants who have various care needs.
- Good communication skills, both written and oral, to ensure clear instruction and documentation.
- Preferred: Bilingual Spanish, Tagalog.
- Able to perform basic math computations.

Minimum Position Requirements:

Experience: Experience working with older adults and adults with developmental disabilities.
